Risk Classification

Market Outlook

The Fund maintains its largest sector positions in Eurozone Electric Utilities and US Diversified Utilities.

Over the month we increased the cash position from 4.1% to 5.1% at the end of May.

Investment Objective

Market Commentary

Global equity markets posted strong gains in May, with the MSCI World index up 4.5%. The rally was driven by a combination of better-than-expected corporate earnings, resilient economic data, and hopes for potential interest rate cuts in 2024.

U.S. CPI data met expectations, boosting U.S. stocks to all-time highs. U.S. Q1 earnings cleared a high bar, showing strong results and signs of broadening. Markets remain sensitive to Fed policy signals and the path of interest rates, lifting the VIX index of implied S&P volatility from four-year lows.

Stronger-than-expected Eurozone inflation figures showed stalling inflation progress on the last day of the month. However, stickier inflation failed to shake investors' conviction that interest rates will fall as European stocks closed the month higher.

A historically weak Japanese yen, near 34-year lows versus the dollar, prompted suspected currency intervention.

As markets expected, the European Central Bank (ECB) cut rates by 25 basis points at the policy meeting the first week of June. Furthermore, we await the results of the European parliamentary election in June and UK general election in July.




Asset Allocation
